

# 9th ABISS welcomes 1303 digital innovators and lays foundation for international follow-up

Press release – Kortrijk, 7 October 2024

On Thursday 3 October 2024, ABISS once again brought together the cream of industrial decision-makers for a successful 9th edition of its annual summit & networking event combination. With a noticeable growth in on-site visitors (+14%), ABISS achieved its target with a total of 1303 visitors comprising 1018 physical and 285 digital participants. This edition once again demonstrated the importance of rapidly adapting digitalization and connectivity within the industry, with a strong focus on innovations around cybersecurity for OT and Industrial AI. The latter topic was elevated from theory to -already actual- practice by numerous concrete demos.

# Versatile programme with 14 well-attended Expert Classes and demos

Visitors could participate in 14 Expert Classes this year, which were intensively attended and attracted a lot of interest. A convivial and friendly networking atmosphere also prevailed alongside the 'learning hubs'. On the exhibition floor, as many as 92 technology partners presented a large number of demos, introducing visitors from OT and IT teams from various industrial sectors to the latest developments and solutions. The variety of technologies and applications, as well as the level of these innovations underlined ABISS' role as the networking platform of choice for industrial digital innovation.

## Next year's anniversary edition and a first ABISS in the Netherlands

The organization is already looking forward to 2025, in which ABISS will not only celebrate its 10th edition in Kortrijk (9 October 2025), but will also organise the first edition in the Netherlands. This first-time Dutch event will take place at Breepark in Breda on Thursday 30 October 2025. After intensive market research, it is clear that the Dutch industrial public can also appreciate this kind of knowledge sharing, tested on the spot against today's possibilities.
